- Jakob Michael Reinhold Lenz: *Der Hofmeister, oder Vorteile der Privaterziehung/The Tutor, or, The Advantages of Private Education* (1774) – drama
- Friederich Schiller: *Kabale und Liebe/Intrigue and Love* (1784) – drama
